MOTION by PDD Golden to approve the Minutes of the 1987 Supreme Growl in Phoenix, Arizona, as mailed. Motion was APPROVED.

Honorable Kennel Dog Trainer PDD Macera led the Assembly in a memorial service to the deceased of the past year.

PCDD Farris read the annual Kennel Financial Report for the past year. Assets of \$19,386.54 were declared.
MOTION by PDD Catuzza to accept the Financial Report, subject to audit, was APPROVED.

The Chairman of the Audit Committee, PCDD Kacsan, gave his report on the audit of the Kennel Books. He stated they were in excellent condition, and balanced. MOTION by PCDD Kacsan to accept audit report was APPROVED.

The National Executive Secretary, PCDD Farris, gave a membership report. The Kennel closed out the Fiscal Year with 1906 members in good standing. Awards were given to the top three Pounds in the Kennel.

PDD Krauss obligated the Devil Dogs and Pups who were initiated and they were dismissed.

Honorable Kennel Smart Dog, PDD Golden, presented changes to the Kennel By-Laws (Attached). MOTION by PDD Colebrook to accept changes was APPROVED.

MOTION by PCDD Sutton to establish a Past Chiefs Society which would establish awards for various purposes - Motion APPROVED.

MOTION by PDD Spears to increase registration fee for the 1989 Supreme Growl to twelve dollars in advance and fifteen dollars at Dallas. This money to be used to help defray cost of 50th Anniversary events. Motion DEFEATED.

The Chairman of the 50th Anniversary Committee, PCDD Gallagher gave an extensive detailed report on the plans for the celebration. (Report on file). Additional plans will be discussed at Mid-Winter Staff.

PDD King reported on his Passport Project. \$1675.00 has been raised for the Childrens Hospital Fund. This is in addition to the \$175.50 from last year.

PKDR Rosen reported that the Annual Kennel Fund Raiser had brought in \$2385.00 of which \$576.00 was carried forward from last Fiscal Year.

Honorable Chief Devil Dog, PDD Thomas A. Banks presented awards to his Staff.

The New Pedigree Devil Dogs were obligated by Honorable Chief Devil Dog PDD Thomas A. Banks.

MOTION by PDD Hastings was APPROVED that the Kennel make the following donations:

AMENDMENTS TO THE KENNEL BY-LAWS APPROVED AT CINCINNATI, OHIO, 4 August 1988

ARTICLE VII - UNIFORM

Section 702, Change following paragraphs to read as follows;

- (A) An embroidered official insignia may be worn on the right sleeve of the shirt with the top of the insignia one-half (2) inch below the shoulder seam.
- (C) Small official insignia sewn on the right side of the overseas cap in such a manner as not to cover any lettering, and such indentifying lettering on the right side of the cap as will be in good taste. No pins stars, medals, or devices should be worn on the cap without the official approval of the Kennel. Gold caps may be worn by Kennel Officers, but, they must revert to the red cap after their term of office. Only Past Chief Devil Dogs may wear the gold cap after their term of office, and dates of tenure must be shown on cap.

Add new paragraph;

(J) Marine Corps Dress Blue w/red stripe or black trousers may be worn with the Devil Dog uniform.

JUSTIFICATION: To bring the uniform regulations for the Kennel up to date and reinsert those provisions that are needed to clarify the Devil Dog uniform.

SECTION 703, Add new paragraph to read as follows

(E) The fiftieth anniversary medalion issued to all present and registered at the Supreme Growl in Dallas, Texas, in 1989, may be worn with, or in lieu of, the official indentification disc (Dog Tag) of the Order.

ARTICLE XII - GENERAL

SECTION 1209 - Life Memberships, following paragraph changed to read as follows;

(E) - 1. The member shall be a Pedigree Devil Dog, shall be a Life Member of the Marine Corps League, and shall have maintained at least five (5) years continuous membership in the Marine Corps League, and shall have no outstanding obligations to either the Order or the League.

JUSTIFICATION: To create more realistic qualifications for Life Membership.

AT THE SUPREME GROWL, IN CINCINNATTI, LAST YEAR, THERE WERE 88 Devil Dogs, elevated to PDD, 2 DD's elevated to that rank, and there were two Pups initiated.

They are colorful, of odd sizes and shapes, most all are humorous in some degree and each has a very useful and designed purpose. They are the passports and passport visa stamps of the National Kennel, the Packs, the Pounds and other main gatherings of the Military Order of Devil Dogs.



At the Grand Growl of the Kennel in 1987 in Phoenix, it was passed on the floor of the Grand Growl of the Kennel, for a Passport to be designed and issued at cost to all members of the Military Order of Devil Dogs, regardless of his rank or degree held in the Devil Dogs. It was further agreed that all monies over and above the actual costs to be used for our annual childrens charity project. Further "All bones (monies) over acutal costs of procuring the passport and printed seal or visa stamps shall be given to the National Kennel's "Children's Ward Hospital Fund".



Failure to carry the Kennel Passport to any Kennel, Pack Pound or other designated event or growl shall result in a fine. The bones raised shall be used each year to obtain some item for a "Childrens Ward" in the city where the Grand Growl of the Kennel shall take place.

The Passport project has been in operation since the 1988 Grand Growl and already has raisled \$700 dollars and there is still half a year to go and many of the Devil Dogs are still unaware of the Passport. The Mid-Winter National Staff meeting will have a good count of the funds raised as well what the Devil Dogs will be able to give to the Childrens Ward in Dallas during our Golden 50th Anniversary of the Devil Dogs.

All Devil Dogs are urged to obtain their passport from their Pound Dog Robber. The Passports are brillant in color and serve a very worthy project of the Military Order of Devil Dogs. The Fun and Honor Society of the Marine Corps League.


