

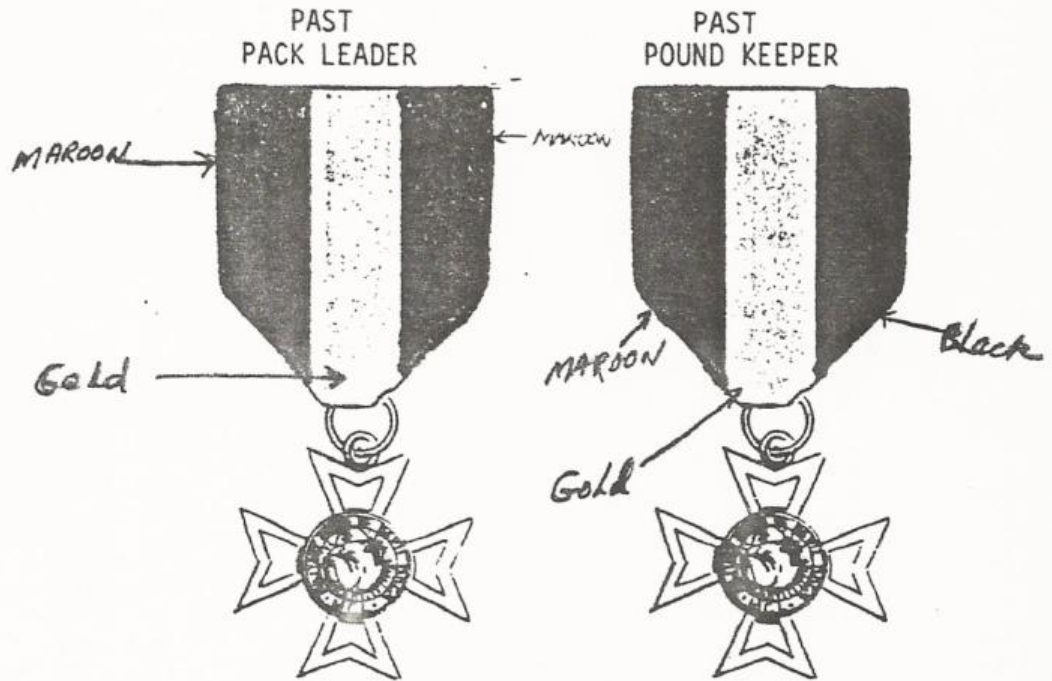
Others that I have misplaced their letters. Thanks to all that sent information in, and I am saving one more for last.

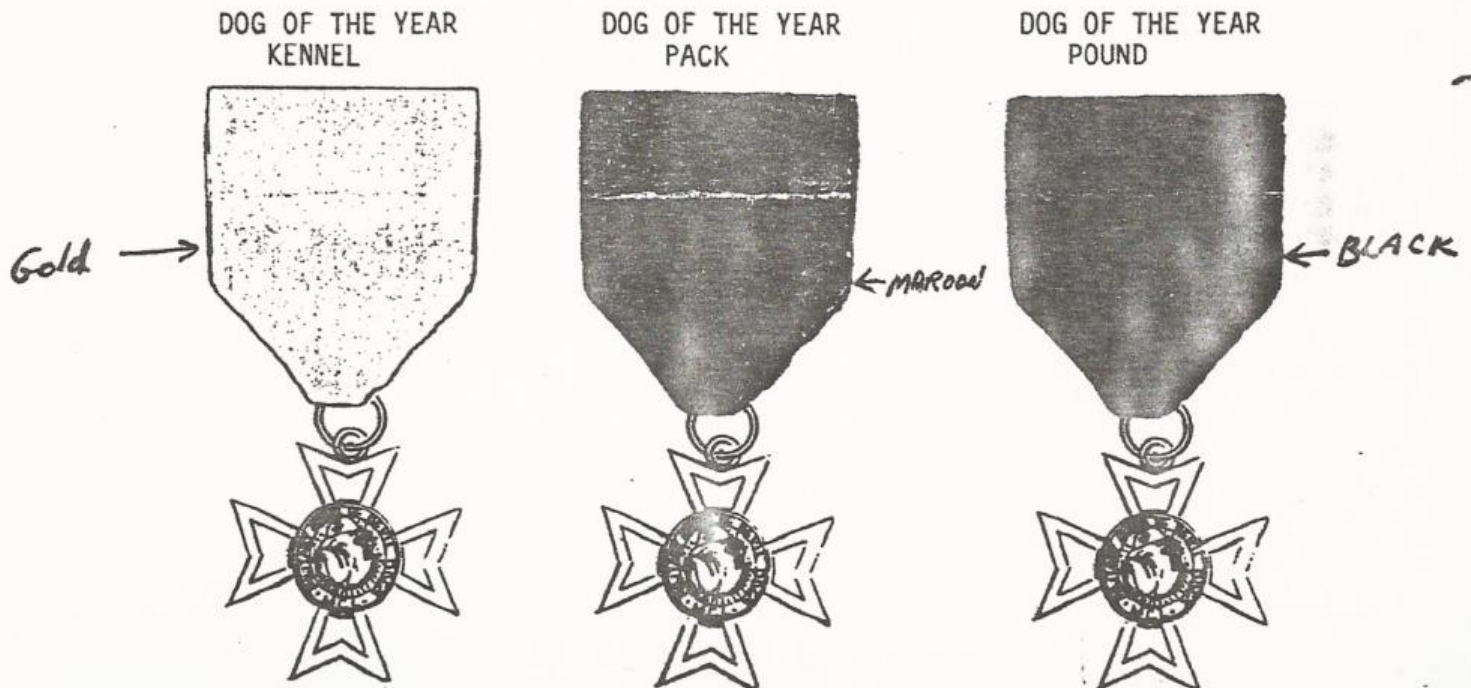



SUBJECT: Report of the proceedings of the Kennel Staff Growl held in Arlington, Virginia at the Westpark Hotel, 19 February 1988

The Mid-Winter Growl of the Kennel Staff was convened on the afternoon of 19 February 1988 at the Rosslyn Westpark Hotel in Arlington, Virginia. The substance of the decisions made at this Growl are as follows;

- (1) PCDD Paul L. Sutton was appointed to the 50th Anniversary Committee by the Chief Devil Dog.
- (2) It was recommended that by-law changes be submitted for action in Cincinnati, on the uniform and the 50th Anniversary Medalion.
- (3) Minutes or newsletters of the various Packs and Pounds should be sent to the Chief Devil Dog or the Kennel Barking Dog.
- (4) PDD Overbeck, Chairman of the 1988 National Convention, reported that the cost of the Luncheon to the Kennel would be approximately \$9.92. He also offered a fashion show at the Luncheon and this was approved.
- (5) It was made clear that any Devil Dog not in good standing with the Marine Corps League would not be in good standing with the Military Order of Devil Dogs (suspension, non-payment of dues, etc).
- (6) 1988 fund raiser tickets will be sent out shortly.
- (7) PCDD Edwin Gallagher, Chairman of the 50th Anniversary Committee briefed the Growl on the plans for the 50th Anniversary celebration at the Supreme Growl in Dallas, Texas in August 1989. Items included the time capsule, a commemorative plate and the medalion that will be issued to all who register and attend the Supreme Growl. This medalion may be worn with the Dog Tags on the ribbon or in place of the Dog Tags. The dye and all medalions left over after the 1989 Supreme Growl will be destroyed. The plate will be offered for sale.

The Chief Devil Dog levied fines in the amount of \$34.35 during the Growl.
