Murrah Federal Building just over 28 years ago, which took the lives of 168 individuals including Marines Sgt Benjamin Laranzo Davis and Capt. Randolph A. Guzman. If you have not been to the Oklahoma City National Memorial and Museum it is a powerful memorial worth the visit. While the attack was an act of domestic terrorism, the memorial offers the opportunity to reflect on and honor not only on those lost on April 19, 1995, but also on our brothers and sisters currently serving; many of them in harm's way, because as we all know, the world is not always a safe place.

Once this WOG is published, the 83rd Supreme Growl and 100th Anniversary Marine Corps League Convention in Oklahoma City will not be far off. It has been an honor to have the opportunity to visit various Pound and Pack Growls around the Kennel! Most recently with Central & Southwest Division Conventions along with Pennsylvania and Missouri Department Conventions with the pleasure of initiating and advancing Dogs, as well as installing newly elected and appointed Pound and Pack Staff. 



SUMMER IS HERE... OORAH !!!

The Marine Corps League National Convention and 83rd Supreme Growl is almost upon us! Looking forward to barking with many of you Dogs in Growl Assembled. Are you ready? My last article was written on 18 MAR 2023. Looking back over my notes and Facebook brings back some good memories from the last three months.

The 19th of March, I accompanied the Honorable 59th Chief Devil Dog PCDD Tom Hazlett to the National Convention hotel in Oklahoma City. The facility is in great shape and the rooms for the Kennel are going to work out well. On the 25th, PDD John Burwitz from the Wisconsin Pack, met me in Wentzville, Missouri for a Growl with the Dogs of

Pound 086. PDD Burwitz has been a “Special Dog” since we met at the Supreme Growl in Springfield, Illinois. The 29th was Vietnam Veterans Day and Chief Hazlett and I, visited the Missouri National Veterans Memorial in Perryville, Missouri. Lest We Forget...

April was a busy month. The 1st was a Missouri Pack Growl in Jefferson City. PDD Jason Reimann made my day when he “Requested a Lawyer.” During his trial a large pile of Big Bones was collected and PDD Reimann ultimately had to apply for a loan, before being found guilty. Fun Growl. The MCL Commandant’s Corner Zoom meeting was held on the 11th. Our topic was the MODD. Some good information was barked about. A deadly tornado touched down in the small, rural community of Glenallen, Missouri. One entire family was killed and most of the area homes were destroyed or severely damaged. On the 13th Dogs from Pound 330, Marines from the local Detachment, Ladies from the MCLA and the DAV teamed up. We gathered enough supplies to feed 250 people. Our volunteers packed up at the Marine Barracks and travelled 35 miles to Glenallen. Our team set up in front of the Post Office. Throughout the afternoon and evening, we fed approximately 200 residents and Disaster Relief Volunteers. Very humbling day. On the 15th PDD Steve Seyller and I, were in Des Moines, Iowa for the Department Quarterly Meeting, and a Growl with Pound 122. The Iowa Dogs are Fired Up! We were back in Cape Girardeau for a Growl with Pound 330 by the 18th. We brought in three new Mongrels and their initiation was fantastic. It was good to see an awesome imitation of “Gunny R. Lee Ermey.” LOTS of laughs that night. The Honorable Deputy Mad Dog PDD CJ New passed away on the 28th. Sad day for our Order. Pound 086 held a Growl in his Honor the next day. Great turnout and many shared memories of PDD CJ “Pickles” New. We will all miss you, Brother. Fair Winds and Following Seas, Marine. Semper Fidelis.

The month of May began with a visit to Minnesota. Karen and I, were in Mankato the 4th – the 7th. The Department Convention was full of familiar faces. The Grand Growl of the Pack was OUTSTANDING. It was real Honor to Obligate Marine Paul Wojahn to PDD. Private Wojahn is now 102 years old! He is a WW II Marine. Enlisted 20 AUG 1942 and fought on New Guinea, Cape Gloucester, Peleliu and Okinawa. WOW. Big Barks to the new Worthy Pack Leader PDD Bill Wittenberg. The 10th & 11th were the Wake and Funeral for PDD New, in St. Louis. Both were very well attended. Many of us gathered for Chow after the funeral. There were many toasts to his memory and we all barked the Devil Dog Creed. Marines are a special breed. The Kennel Staff met online on the 13th. The Honorable 60th Chief Devil Dog CDD Alan Sanning has kept his Staff focused on OKC. It was motivating to recognize DD Matt Anders as the Pound Dog of the Year at a ceremony on the 21st in Cape Girardeau. BIG BARKS! Met with the Kennel Bylaws Committee on the 22nd via Zoom. We are ready for the presentation of the five proposed Bylaws changes at the Supreme Growl. The weather for Memorial Day this year was perfect. Attended two ceremonies locally. Todd Calaway 1995, Darrell Boatman 2005, and Brett

Angus 2005. I remember you! On the 30th the Missouri Pack held a Zoom meeting to discuss the Annual Pack Fundraiser. These online meetings are a great tool and provide a perfect opportunity to work out details prior to the discussion and vote at a Growl.

June started with a visit to Branson, Missouri. The Department Convention and Grand Growl of the Pack were held on the 10th. We had 53 Dogs on deck. There were 10 Pups elevated to DD. The laughter and shenanigans never stopped. The Pack donated 10, 500 Big Bones to the Pediatric Ward of Mercy Hospital in Springfield, Missouri. Our Pack has contributed 12,172 Big Bones to the Kennel Children's Hospital Donation this year. Our 6 Pounds sent in an additional 10,364 Big Bones. This gives us a total of 22,536 Big Bones from Missouri to the Kennel Children's Hospital Donation for this year! To sum it all up, the 179 Dogs in Missouri donated a total of 33,036 Big Bones to the children this year. That is almost 185 Big Bones raised by each Dog. WOW. This was my last Growl as the Worthy Pack Leader. It was truly an Honor to serve the Pack. On the 20th we held a growl for Pound 330 in Cape Girardeau. The Honorable 58th Chief Devil Dog PCDD Leonard Spicer was in attendance, but definitely feeling a little "Under the Weather". Drove up to Wentzville on the 24th for a FUN Growl with Pound 086. Sir Pound Keeper PDD Mark Hoernschemeyer always runs a good Growl and he was chosen as the Missouri Pack Dog of the Year for 2023. Well earned, Marine!

I have approved the Bylaws for the Iowa Pack. They were submitted several years ago and got lost in the shuffle. Many of you have reached out to me with questions about the Bylaws. Most of you know that I will always do my best to answer those questions ASAP. Please give your Pound and Pack Smart Dog the opportunity to answer your questions before reaching out to me. No Dog needs to memorize the Bylaws, but EVERY Dog should have a working knowledge of them. This is especially true for the Officers on all three levels. Pound, Pack and Kennel. We have five Proposed Bylaws Changes that will be presented and voted on at the 83rd Supreme Growl, on 16 AUG 2023, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. You will find those five changes here in this issue of the Woof-O-Gram. They are also posted on the Kennel website: MilitaryOrderoftheDevilDogs.org. Scroll down to: "2023 SUPREME GROWL" and click on the **INFO** tile. Scroll down to: "2023 PROPOSED CHANGES". Here is a brief summary.

- #1. Stamps. This change would add several Passport Stamps to the authorized list.
- #2. KDOY Chair. This change calls for the Chair of the Kennel Dog of the Year Committee to be elected for a one-year term.
- #3. KDOY Selection. This change would limit the selection process of the Kennel Dog of the Year to the KDOY Committee only.
- #4. Awards Submission. This change concerns the Pound and Pack Dog Robber of the Year. It would change the submission date, for Nomination Letters, to 1 June.
- #5. Pins. This change adds to the list of authorized pins on the MODD Collar. It would allow all MCL, MODD and Service pins.

Please take the time to read these and share them with your Pounds and Packs. Only the Dogs in attendance at the Supreme Growl will be able to vote on these proposed changes.

Proposed ByLaw Changes

Subject: Proposed Military Order of the Devil Dogs Constitution & Bylaws Amendment

ARTICLE IV - THE KENNEL

Existing Wording:

Section 505 - Passports and Visa Stamps

- A. All Devil Dogs shall procure a MODD Passport at a cost regulated by the Kennel, which will distribute them to the Packs and the Pounds. The fine for attending any Kennel, Pack or Pound Growl will be one dollar (\$1.00) without a passport in any attending Devil Dogs possession.
- B. The Kennel, Packs and Pounds will procure a Visa Stamp to stamp all Passports with the date of all Growls attended by said Devil Dog presenting their Passport. Cost of Visa stamping shall be one dollar (\$1.00).
- C. All monies collected for Passport or Visa stamping shall be forwarded after each growl to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber, who will hold these monies in a special Passport account.
- D. All monies collected will be used each year at the Marine Corps League, Inc., National Convention, where a check for a sizable portion of that account will be presented first, to a children's hospital in the convention city, or to another suitable local charity as the Executive Board of the Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc., may select. The check shall be accompanied by a letter stipulating that the Order's contribution is to be used for special equipment purchases only and for no other purpose.
- E. Any Devil Dog Passport that is lost, or misplaced, not stolen, if turned into either the Kennel, Pack or Pound Dog Robber, shall be stamped four times and returned at a cost of two dollars (\$2.00), as a finder's fee.

Proposed Wording:

Section 505 - Passports and Visa Stamps

- A. All Devil Dogs shall procure a MODD Passport at a cost regulated by the Kennel, which will distribute them to the Packs and the Pounds. The fine for attending any Kennel, Pack or Pound Growl will be one dollar (\$1.00) without a passport in any attending Devil Dogs possession.
- B. The Kennel, Packs and Pounds will procure a Visa Stamp to stamp all Passports with the date of all Growls attended by said Devil Dog presenting their Passport. Cost of Visa stamping shall be one dollar (\$1.00).
- C. Additional Passport stamps can be procured by the following Officers or Events of the M.O.D.D.: Pound Dog Robber, Pack Dog Robber, Pack Leader (Current and Past), Division Vice Chief Devil Dog (Current and Past), Kennel Dog Robber, Current Elected Kennel Officers, Chief Devil Dog (Current and Past). Other Approved Stamps would be Pack Anniversary, Special Growls of the Kennel (Gatherings), Mini-Growl and Supreme Growl.
- D. All monies collected for Passport or Visa stamping shall be forwarded after each growl to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber, who will hold these monies in a special Passport account.
- E. All monies collected will be used each year at the Marine Corps League, Inc., National Convention, where a check for a sizable portion of that account will be presented first, to a children's hospital in the convention city, or to another suitable local charity as the Executive Board of the Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc., may select. The check shall be accompanied by a letter stipulating that the Order's contribution is to be used for special equipment purchases only and for no other purpose.
- F. Any Devil Dog Passport that is lost, or misplaced, not stolen, if turned into either the Kennel, Pack or Pound Dog Robber, shall be stamped four times and returned at a cost of two dollars (\$2.00), as a finder's fee.

Rationale:

The Passport Stamp is a way of increasing the amount of Bones delivered to the Childrens Hospital Fund. The

proceeds of the Non-Dog Robber Passport Stamps will be Included in the Donation to the Childrens Hospital Fund as an Additional Donation. ONLY the Dog Robber Passport Stamps would be counted as Attendance for the Growl.

- a. The Kennel Dog of the Year Committee shall be comprised of all past recipients of the Kennel Dog of the Year Award attending the National Convention who attend the committee meeting,
- b. Said meeting will be scheduled by the chair prior to the Supreme Growl with reasonable notice given to all eligible members.
- c. The Committee shall have no less than three (3) members.
- d. Each member must be a member in good standing of the Marine Corps League and Military Order of the Devil Dogs. The Chair of the Committee shall be Elected by the members of the Committee for a term of one (1) year.

c. The Committee shall have no less than three (3) members.



ARTICLE IV - THE KENNEL

Existing Wording:

MEMBERSHIP AWARDS

No ribbon or medal authorized for these awards:

The PCDD Gerald L. Bakelaar Award, which is named after the first Chief Devil Dog, recognizes the Top Pound in the Kennel for Membership during the previous fiscal year.

The PDD Howard D. Goslin Award, which is named after a great PDD, recognizes the Top Pack in the Kennel for Membership during the previous fiscal year.

The PDD James F. Powell Award, which is named after our Kennel Quartermaster of many years, recognizes the Top Division in the Kennel for membership during the previous fiscal year.

Note 1: For each additional medal or ribbon award, a 5/16" gold star will be worn for each additional award, and a 5/16" Silver Star will be worn in place of five (5) gold stars.

Note 2: For each additional medal or ribbon award, a 3/16" bronze star will be worn in lieu of an additional medal/ribbon. A 3/16" Silver Star will be worn in place of five (5) bronze stars, and a 3/16" gold star will be worn in place of five (5) silver stars.

Note 3: As voting members of the Kennel Awards Committee, the Kennel Dog Robber and Kennel National Executive Director will be asked to provide supporting data attesting to the quality of reports submitted by nominees for the above awards.

Letters of nomination in sealed envelopes marked for either "Pack Dog Robber of the Year" or "Pound Dog Robber of the Year" must be received by Registered US Mail or delivered by hand at the National Convention in the Kennel Dog House by the close of business (1700 Local Time) on Monday during the National Convention. Winners will be announced at the Supreme Growl.

Proposed Wording:

MEMBERSHIP AWARDS

No ribbon or medal authorized for these awards:

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Letters of nomination in sealed envelopes marked for either "Pack Dog Robber of the Year" or "Pound Dog Robber of the Year" must be received by Registered US Mail or email to the Kennel Executive Director by Close of Business 1 June prior to the Supreme Growl. Winners will be announced at the Supreme Growl.

Rationale:

Having a longer amount of time to review the Submission Packages will ensure that the Candidates are given the amount of time needed to select the best Package.

Subj: Proposed Change to Kennel Bylaws

Ref: Kennel Bylaws Article XIII Section 1301

I would like to recommend the following proposed bylaw change for consideration.

Article VII section 703, sub section C. Identification Disc and Dog Collar;

Currently reads:

C. A maximum of two (2) emblems, plus one official Dog Tag Disc, may be worn at any one time, on the Dog Collar. Emblems may include the American Flag, Marine Corps emblem, Marine Corps League Inc., membership pin, Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc., membership pin, the POW/MIA pin, the VAVS award for hours served (white oval pin with blue figure and red heart indicating number of hours served), and the Bull Dog. Except as may be specifically authorized elsewhere in these Bylaws, no other devices or emblems maybe worn on the Dog Collar. All other emblems shall be subject to one fine for each unauthorized emblem.

Change to read:

C. A maximum of two (2) emblems, plus one official Dog Tag Disc, may be worn at any one time, on the Dog Collar. Emblems may include the American Flag, Marine Corps emblem, Marine Corps League Inc. pins, Military Order of the Devil Dogs, Inc. pins, the POW/MIA pin, the VAVS award for hours served (white oval pin with blue figure and red heart indicating number of hours served), Military Service pins and the Bull Dog. Except as may be specifically authorized elsewhere in these Bylaws, no other devices or emblems maybe worn on the Dog Collar. All other emblems shall be subject to one fine for each unauthorized emblem.

Rational:

Members of our Order should be authorized to wear all Marine Corps League pins, Military Order of the Devil Dogs pins and Military Service pins.



We have some fun and interesting things planned for the initiates so come prepared to do a little snooping around, sharpen up your memory skills and there might be some singing and dancing as well.



DD Advancement Information

Woof Woof Dogs of the Order.

For those of you who are planning to advance this year in Oklahoma City please look at the requirements and this helpful information.

- 1- All Advancement forms should have been sent to the Kennel Dog Robber and received by July 1st.
- 2- All advancing Dogs need to first register with the MCL then proceed to the Kennel Doghouse to Register.
All Dogs Must be at the Doghouse no later than 1700 on August 14th, 2023. It is recommended to arrive on Sunday if possible or as early as you can on Monday.
- 3- Each Dog Needs to Bring \$50.00 - \$75.00 big bones with them to the Doghouse for registration. There is a \$25.00 big bone fee for your dog collar which \$20.00 of that is refundable at the end of your initiation if you don't want to keep your collar. You'll have your Passport fee and registration fee, there will be a Growl specific coin and patch that you can purchase, your Dog Bones and possible fines that may be given.
- 4- You need to have a list of your Medicines and any specific medical issues that you might have so they can be given to the Kennel Vet and your Platoon Handler. Please put this on a 3X5 index card if possible. If you need to use more than one card that's fine.
- 5- **DD's need to make sure they do not book any trips from August 14th – 16th.** If you miss too much of the training, we won't be able to Advance you.





The Supreme Growl is fast approaching. It's time to start sending advancements for PDD in – remember they need to be in my paws NLT 1 July. **Hint- Hint**, they can be emailed to me after your Pack Dog Robber signs them. Per the updated bylaws the candidates for PDD must be in attendance by 1700 on Monday the 14th of August. Be sure to arrive early because you have to pick up your credentials from the MCL Registration desk prior to reporting to the Doghouse.

At the Supreme Growl, awards will be given out. To date I have received only three submissions. Two for Kennel Dog of the Year and one for Pound Dog Robber of the Year. Really, are there no other Dogs deserving recognition for a job well done? **I can't believe that!** There is still time to get those nominations in – they will be accepted, even hand delivered – just be sure to follow the instructions in the bylaws.



Passport stamping fees and donations to our Childrens Hospital Fund continue to arrive. Remember the bylaws require each pound to have a minimum of four growls each fiscal year and those bones collected for the stamping and donations to the Childrens Hospital are to be sent into me within a few days after the growl – so don't wait until the end of the fiscal year. All checks dated 30 June 2023 and prior will go to this year's donation to the Children's Hospital Fund.

I continue receiving ROIs done on **OUTDATED** forms and with everyone living in the same **PO Box – it must be really crowded!!!** We need the physical address that your officers live at plus phone number and email address. Also many pounds are still holding their elections prior to the Supreme Growl. Bylaws require the Pound election and installation to be done within **90 days after** the Supreme Growl. Only the Pack can hold elections prior to the Supreme Growl since their Grand Growls generally are held right around the end of the Fiscal Year (30 June).

My deputies are still finding many pounds and packs that are not incorporated and/or using incorrect EINs. We need to get this corrected ASAP – if you need help, just ask. We have many dogs that can assist you.

The Mini Growl held on 24 February in Norfolk, VA is on the website under private library. Also, last year's Supreme Growl Scratchings are located there. Read them prior to coming to Oklahoma City – they will be voted on for approval or corrections so check them out.

When you send in your transmittals, applications for membership, advancements and NOD, you need to only send one copy of each. I don't need three copies of everything! **If you are not getting your endorsed copies back, the reason is either your email isn't correct, or you do not have one. In which case, you need to provide me with a valid email address.**

Have a safe and enjoyable summer and I hope to see many of you in Oklahoma City.



In a perfect world, when a new Dog Robber takes over in a Pound, all the books will be perfect, all the reports will have been filed, audits complete, etc. Yeah, that didn't happen when I took over as our Pound Dog Robber in 2019. So sit back, grab a cold one, and let me tell you a little story about getting our Pound back in compliance. Are you ready? Let's go!

In 2019, I was a newly minted DD and I was asked to take over as Dog Robber. Since I have a bookkeeping background and have worked in the nonprofit world before joining the League, I was on board. I assumed that the batch of "stuff" I received would be a good set of financials and minutes. I was so wrong. I was given a binder of random information, a few old bank statements, our passport stamp, and a so-called roster. I asked about a bank account and was told that we hadn't had a bank account in at least a year. After hearing that, I wondered what the heck I had gotten myself into! Like any good Marine, I took a deep breath, pulled up my britches and got focused on the task at hand. I knew it would take some work, but I knew if anyone was going to get it done, it was me!

Step one, getting our bank account so we had somewhere to collect finances. That was probably the easiest part! We did, at least, have our EIN from the IRS, so I was able to knock that out pretty quickly. I then had to double check our 990N filings and make sure they were up to date. Fortunately, this was another easy task with the online 990N filing access and I got all the filings caught up in short order.

The next step was a bit harder, I had to check with our Secretary of State on our Charity filing. I was able to find our filing information and had to contact the Secretary of State to obtain access to our records. I didn't have our Filing ID, so that was probably the biggest challenge. For a small number of charities, an exemption can be filed to avoid having to file an annual financial report. Our Pound qualifies for this exemption, which took a large piece of paperwork off my desk. I do have to file the request each year, but with the online filing, an email reminder is sent annually so I don't miss it!

The next step was probably the most challenging, getting the records in order with what hand-written minutes I could decipher and getting our roster and contact information for our Pound members put together in a digital format that could be disseminated to Pound members and utilized for communication efforts. It took a couple of months of reaching out to Pound members by mail, since our Pound consists of three Detachments across the eastern part of our State, to get the roster fully updated and begin communications with all our Pound members. This communication has helped with improving attendance at our Growls, which has helped with our fund-raising efforts. I now have our roster in an Excel spreadsheet with all the important information and we send dues renewal invoices via Square, which makes it easy for Pound members to pay dues without having to send a check. If they choose to pay with credit cards, we ask that they cover the processing fee so the Pound doesn't lose funds.

Finally, we had to tackle the fact that we had no bylaws and budget for guidance on managing our Pound, especially on distribution of funds outside of Passport Fees and Dues. This allowed us to have clear outline for ensuring we have funds to cover administrative costs, awards, and funds for Operation Chowhound and the Childrens Hospital donations.

It realistically took about six months or so to tackle all these issues and get our Pound back on track with all the required elements we must have to comply. It wasn't always easy, but I knew it must be done and I wasn't going to let my Pound down. The biggest key is knowing what parts you need to cover to be in compliance with the Pack, Kennel, State, and IRS. Each state has different requirements, but if you reach out to your Secretary of State Charitable Division, they are normally more than happy to assist in getting you on the right track, even if your Pound or Pack has been out of compliance for some time.

In the midst of straightening all these issues out, I may have consumed an adult beverage or two, but at the end of the day, it was worth it and my Pound and I have no worries that we are going to get a nasty gram from the State or worse, from the Kennel, suspending us for noncompliance. It can be done and more importantly, it MUST be done. The issues that arise from not doing it are WAY more serious than can be handled by most Pounds and it takes much less time to maintain compliance than to let it slide. Don't be that Pound! There are plenty of Dogs who are here to lend a hand if you need some guidance. Lean on them and ensure that you are doing things the right way!
