 - MODD Distinguished Service Award
 - May be awarded to a Dog, business or non-member.
 - No specific criteria.
 - MODD Life Membership Certificate.
 - May be awarded to a Dog after they become an MODD Life Member.














- Kennel Dog of the Year Medal (and ribbon).

 - Awarded by the Honorable Chief Devil Dog.



 - Can be a PDD or DD or Pup
 - Must be in good standing with the MODD and MCL to include paid membership dues.
 - A proposed candidate shall be a Dog of integrity, principles and who has contributed to the MODD.
 - The rules for nomination, submission and selection are covered in the Section 417 of the Kennel Bylaws.









- Pound Keeper's Meritorious Commendation Ribbon (Individual).
 - · Recognition for exceptionally meritorious service to the Pound.
 - Awarded by the Sir/Madame Pound Keeper.







- Past Chief Devil Dog Medal (and ribbon).
 - · Awarded to Chief Devil Dogs upon completion of a term office.







- Past Pack Leader Medal (and ribbon).
 - Awarded to Pack Leaders upon completion of a term office.





- Past Pound Keeper Medal (and ribbon).
 - Awarded to Pound Keepers upon completion of a term office.



Special Kennel Awards 1




- Past Chief Devil Dog Award (no medal or ribbon).
 - Presented by the Past Chief Devil Dogs Society to a PDD in recognition of their exceptional service to the MODD and to their community. This award is second only to the Kennel Dog of the Year as the most prestigious award given by the MODD.

- PCDD John Zak Award (no medal or ribbon).
 - Recognizes the outstanding Pound Dog Robber of the Year.
 - Candidates must have a minimum of three (3) years in office.
 - Nomination Letter must be signed by the Pound Keeper and endorsed by another elected Pound Officer.
 - The rules for nomination, submission and selection are covered in Enclosure 1 of the Kennel Bylaws.

- PCDD Kenneth E. Farris Award (no medal or ribbon).
 - Recognizes the outstanding Pack Dog Robber of the Year.
 - Candidates must have a minimum of three (3) years in office.

 - The rules for nomination, submission and selection are covered in Enclosure 1 of the Kennel Bylaws.
