

Attended a birthday ball in Lakes Region of NH and what a wonderful time-Thank you Lakes Region Detachment and Commandant Patenaude.



You stand to lose your nonprofit status if you do not comply with the IRS regulations. Send the IRS notice of filing to me so it and your EIN number may be recorded. The IRS is making a big push to shut down non-profits that do not file. If you do not have an EIN number, you need to get one and send the number to me so we can get you on the list of MCL subsidiaries and registered as such with the IRS. Noncompliance may result in taxes being imposed on any income as well as severe penalties from the IRS.

We are all looking forward to the Mid-Winter Growl in Virginia in February. I hope to see many of you in attendance. Remember, this is the only Kennel level growl that any Dog may attend. After you have made sure that you have complied with all of the above, you can go back to your nap by the fireplace and make sure the food and water bowl are close by so that you do not have to exert yourself too much. Have a Merry Christmas and I wish each and every one a joyous and prosperous New Year.
