Please keep him in your prayers as he works his way through recovery!

Now onto brighter topics, it was an honor to join with approximately 500 other Dogs to be a part of the 100th Anniversary of the Marine Corps League and our 83rd Supreme Growl in Oklahoma City in August. Thanks to all of you in attendance for making it such a great time. Of the Dogs on hand, we had 113 advanced to Pedigreed Devil Dog and two made Devil Dog, BIG BARKS to all of you and many thanks to all of the Dog Handlers, Monitors and all the other dedicated Dogs, including those working the Dog House who had a paw in the process, it could not be accomplished without all of your efforts.

Also, in the honor category, kudos to all of you Dogs involved in fundraising efforts over the last year to support your MODD's donation to the Oklahoma Children's Hospital during the convention. The Oklahoma Pack set up a fun filled Dogs Day in the Park and the events were kicked off with Dogs from around the country participating in the presentation of 74,000 Big Bones to Sara Jacobson of the hospital. Following the presentation, we got down to business with Kennel auctioneer PDD Chuck Minton auctioning off the opportunity to pick from over 20 volunteers from Kennel Staff, Past Chief Devil Dogs, Dog Handlers, etc.... to either throw a pie at, or drop them in the dunk tank. The bids were flying fast as were the pies and while a few dogs came out of it a bit soggy than others the smiles and laughs were abundant among targets, as well as all others present.



Between the Talent -No Talent Contest, Dogs Day in the Park, all of the great items donated from around the Kennel for our raffles and auction, as well as a fun Supreme Growl we not only had a fantastic time, but also ended up with an outstanding start to fundraising for the Children's Hospital donation at the 84th Supreme Growl in Rancho Mirage, CA. To all involved in setting up, donating to or participating in the aforementioned events, your generosity, motivation and hard work are inspiring, WOOF -WOOF!

Finishing up with fundraising, I would be remiss if I didn't recognize the MO Pack and Pounds for hitting it out of the park this year with right at 22,460 big bones going to this year's Kennel Children's Hospital donation. They did that while also donating 10,500 for the Pack designated Children's Hospital during their Grand Growl. Combined from Passport fees and fundraising efforts that comes to an average of around 184.13 for each of the 179 Dogs in Missouri. Big Barks to the MO Pack and Pounds and all the other Packs and Pounds that are making similar efforts in our mission to help sick children. I urge the Packs and Pounds who are not already active in raising funds, other than Passport Fees, to find a fundraiser to undertake. Even an average of only 20 big bones per Dog would make a big difference in the annual donation and that shouldn't take much of a fundraiser effort wise.

We still have Pounds out of compliance with the Bylaws concerning when the annual Growl of the Pound and elections are to be held, following are a couple lines from the Bylaws on the requirements:

Section 210 – Election


- A. The annual Growl of the Pound shall be held during the three months following the Supreme Growl of the Kennel.
- B. At the annual Growl of the Pound, the officers of the Pound shall be nominated, elected and installed.

For additional info on Section 210, you'll find the Bylaws under the Library tab in Publications at militaryorderofthedevidogs.org. This year the Supreme Growl of the Kennel was held on August 16th, so Pounds have from then until November 16th to hold elections and submit their new Installation Reports to the Kennel Dog Robber. For Pounds that held elections at another time of year, you need to schedule another Growl and hold elections prior to November 16th, submit the Installation Report and you will be back in compliance on this requirement.

Fortunately, there are fewer Dogs showing up each year for advancement whose Application for Degree Advancement was never received or processed by the Kennel Dog Robber. Beginning in 2016 and every year since, a tab has been placed on the Supreme Growl page of the Kennel website with info for Dogs planning to advance at the next Supreme Growl. One tool on that page is a sortable list with the names of all the Dogs whose advancement forms have been received and processed (approved), for advancement. The list can be reviewed by any Dog to ensure their paperwork has been processed prior to them spending big bones to attend the Supreme Growl for advancement, only to be turned away because their form was not received and processed. By now all Dogs should know to check the list to ensure they are good to go before spending bones on travel, however out of about 30 Dogs lined up to go through the Dog House, only about half said that they knew anything about the online list or being able to check it. The Bits & Bytes Dog, PDD Soldano goes to extra lengths to make the list as useful and easy to search as possible, please pass this information to the Dogs in your Packs and Pounds to ensure they aren't turned away.

Thanks for all you do to support your Pounds, Packs, Kennel & the kids. Keep up your great work & fun!

First of all I would like to thank the membership for reelecting me as your Senior Vice Chief Devil Dog. I am here to serve you.

We had a GREAT time in Oklahoma City at the 100th Anniversary National Convention and our 83rd Supreme Growl. I would like to Congratulate the 116 new Pedigree Devil Dogs. I would also like to send a big THANK YOU to PDD Sal Cenicacelaya, Pup Angie Maness and the entire Oklahoma Convention Committee. You all did an amazing job, everyone had a GREAT week. To start the week off there was a No-Talent Talent Show. The Village People



made an encore appearance along with other celebrities. The night was a lot of fun and 2,400 Big Bones were raised for the Children's Hospital Fund. Tuesday morning we made a Donation to the Oklahoma Children's Hospital in the amount of 74,000 Big Bones.



I would like to thank every Dog from around the Kennel who has help support Operation Chow Hound since it was started in 2007 with local donations. We are really making a difference. This year in OKC there was a Patch sale with the proceeds to be donated to a local shelter. We started off with the small Operation Chow Hound Patches in March and then when we linked up with Tornado Alley Bull Dog Rescue, we procured bigger Patches with T.A.B.D.R.'s logo with O.C.H.'s logo embedded in it. The patches were a little late coming

in but we still sold enough (Thank you DD Stephanie Abbott) to add another 1,080 Bones to the Donation for a Total of 2,080 Big Bones to their Shelter. That being said, I still have some of the bigger T.A.B.D.R. Patches and Stickers if you are interested in them. The Patch is 6 Bones or a combo of the Patch and Sticker for 10 Bones, this includes shipping. My mailing address is at the end of this document.

If you have ever noticed me at the beginning of a Growl or a MCL meeting you see that I Salute the Colors then I remove my Cover and Place it over my Heart and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. The United States Flag Code states "Sec 172. Pledge of allegiance to the flag; manner of delivery. Should be rendered by standing at attention facing the flag with the right hand over the heart." With that being said, we being Marines should ALWAYS do what we know is right. During the Staff Growl on Thursday after the Supreme Growl, I made a motion for us the M.O.D.D. to change the way we Honor the Flag. The motion was seconded and discussion occurred. After discussion a Vote taken and Passed that the Military Order of the Devil Dogs will NO longer Remain Covered, Salute and Recite the Pledge. The correct method will be: Advance and Post the Colors, Render a Hand Salute, Cut, Uncover and Recite the Pledge. Then the Chair will instruct the Dog Trainer to Open the Bible and offer the Opening Prayer. After the Prayer the Dog Trainer will then Close the Bible, and the Chair will instruct the Body to Cover. There will be a new page of the Ritual produced and be able to be downloaded from our website. Then the new page can be installed in your Ritual to make it current and not have to purchase



a complete new Ritual.

Any questions please reach out to me and I will do my best to get you the answers needed.



Congratulations to the Honorable 60th Chief Devil Dog CDD Alan Sanning and all of the Kennel Officers on their re-election. Kudos to the 115 Devil Dogs who Advanced to PDD. Big Barks to the new PDD Todd Carpenter! It was an Honor to present you with your Gold Collar. Still remember the first time we met, in



April of 2021, at the 2nd Gathering of the Dogs in Greenville, South Carolina. You were a Motivated Mongrel then and you are a real asset to the North Carolina Pack and the MODD now. WOOF WOOF WOOF !!!

During the month of July, I reviewed and approved the Bylaws for the Florida Pack. It was a very smooth process working with Worthy Smart Dog DD Rick Bedford. Great bunch of Dogs! On the 19th Pound 66 held a Growl in St. Louis. The "road trip" up was a lot of fun with the Honorable 59th Chief Devil Dog PCDD Tom Hazlett, Honorable Compliance Dog PDD Steve Seyller and I, enjoying a stop for Dunkin Donuts coffee.

August began with a Growl with Pound 383 in Jackson, Tennessee on the 5th. Sir Pound Keeper DD Andy Vistrand built an awesome podium for the Pound. Always great to see PDD Bryce West and meet some new Tennessee Marines. Thank you for the hospitality, Brothers! We were in Oklahoma City the 10th - 19th for the National Convention and 83rd Supreme Growl. Very memorable event. Check out the photographs on the Kennel Facebook page!

The 15th of September the Honorable 60th Chief Devil Dog, the Honorable Midwest Division Vice Chief Devil Dog PDD Bill Wittenberg and I, were in St. Joseph, Missouri. We attended a Growl with Pound 110 to help with the Election and Installation of Officers. DD Richard Hardy was Obligated to PDD by the Chief and it was a real Honor to assist with his Advancement. The next morning PDD Wittenberg and I, took the time to pay our respects at the grave of 1st Lt. Jack Schneider USMC. Born 8 APR 1897, he served in the 6th Regiment, 80th Company during WW I. Lt. Schneider fought in the battles of Chateau Thierry, Belleau Woods and was wounded on 19 JUL 1918 during the Battle of Siossons. He was Killed in Action, on 1 NOV 1918, during the Battle of Meuse-Argonne near Exermont, France, just 10 days before the end of the War. Lt. Schneider was one of the Marines who earned our title "Teufel Hunden" Devil Dog. Very humbling to salute this brave Marine. Lest we Forget... The 19th was a Growl with Pound 330 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. The Honorable 58th Chief Devil Dog PCDD Leonard Spicer was on deck and keeping a watchful eye on the new Pups. Always an Honor to conduct the Election and Install the new Officers. Big Barks to our new Sir Pound Keeper PDD Bob Fisher and his Staff.

We had five Proposed Bylaws Changes that were presented and voted on at the 83rd Supreme Growl in Oklahoma City. Big Barks to the Kennel Bylaws Committee for all of the time and effort you put in.

PCDD Hazlett, PDD Minton, PDD Johnson, PDD Dressler, PDD Sturm and PDD Bryan you are all truly dedicated to the Kennel. Dogs will find all five proposed changes posted on the Kennel website: MilitaryOrderoftheDevilDogs.org. Click on: "2023 Supreme Growl after action" and scroll down.

Here is a brief summary:

- #1. Stamps. This change would add several Passport Stamps to the authorized list. REJECTED
- #2. KDOY Chair. This change calls for the Chair of the Kennel Dog of the Year Committee to be elected for a one-year term. REJECTED
- #3. KDOY Selection. This change would limit the selection process of the Kennel Dog of the Year to the KDOY Committee only. APPROVED
- #4. Awards Submission. This change concerns the Pound and Pack Dog Robber of the Year. It would change the submission date, for Nomination Letters, to 1 June. APPROVED
- #5. Pins. This change adds to the list of authorized pins on the MODD Collar. It would allow all MCL, MODD and Service pins. APPROVED

The Kennel Bylaws have been updated with the three approved 2023 changes. The Bylaws have been updated, corrected and modified many times over the years. The PDF/Word Document was badly in need of reformatting. I reached out to my go to Admin Expert, PDD Ray Morrell and he volunteered to attempt to reformat them, but warned me there would be a lot of minor discrepancies. The Mission was a success but he was correct about minor mistakes. After 32 hours on the computer and a few headaches, I managed to correct most of the mistakes, but I did miss a few. Please email me if you catch missing commas, spacing issues, etc. I appreciate the Dogs who have contacted me already. The new Table of Contents is interactive when viewing the Bylaws on a computer. Just click on the Section you are looking for and the program will take you to that page in the Bylaws. They should be easier to read now.

REMINDER !!!

It is time for Pound Elections!

Have you scheduled the "Annual Growl of the Pound"?

The Election of Officers for the Pound is upon us.

Refer to Section 205 in the Kennel Bylaws.

Marines believe in the KISS principle.

KEEP IT SIMPLE STUPID

A good "Sea Lawyer" can nitpick this to death, but...

What is a good way to remember when you hold the Election of Officers for your Pound?

When you come back from the National Convention, we should hold our Pound Election before the Marine Corps Birthday. If you teach your Dogs this way, they will not forget it.

Unlike some of our MCL Detachments, the MODD is very simple. We hold our Nominations, Election and Installation all at the same time, during the same Growl. YOU MUST BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT in the Growl to be nominated.

Remember the KISS principle...

Here is the applicable section from our Bylaws:

Section 205 - Growls - Regular, Annual, Special and Staff

A. REGULAR - Each Pound shall hold no less than four regular assemblies during any fiscal year, which assemblies shall include the annual assembly of the Pound, for the election of officers.

B. ANNUAL - Each Pound shall hold one annual assembly to be held during the three months following the month of the Supreme Growl of the Kennel. This assembly may be one of the regular assemblies specified in Paragraph A, above, and shall be designated a Growl of the Pound. At this annual Growl of the Pound the full

order of business shall be called and acted upon, including the nomination, election and installation of Officers, and at which Growl the outgoing officers shall make full and proper reports and accounting to the Pound. The Installation Report for the new officers shall be submitted to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber no later than the end of the month immediately following the Growl. The Installation Report shall be submitted via the Worthy Pack Dog Robber, if there is such, and a copy shall be sent to the respective Division Vice. Chief Devil Dog.

If you have Bylaws questions or I can help you in any way, please contact me.

The 5th – 7th of October is almost upon us. Looking forward to seeing many of you at the Gathering of the Dogs in Maryland Heights, near St. Louis. This year's event was created by the Midwest Division and will be hosted by the Missouri Pack. The Honorable 60th Chief Devil Dog will be on deck and has promised to make the Growl a "Memorable Experience". The Gatherings are always a fun time. Karen and I, plan to attend and take advantage of some down time. Looking forward to seeing old friends and getting to know some of you better.

Everyone is planning Marine Corps Ball celebrations this time of year. This is a great opportunity to recruit new Marines to the MCL and invite that great Detachment Member to join the MODD. Are they a Regular Member of the MCL? Do they have at least 12 months in the Detachment? Have they been working hard for the Detachment this past year? Are they MOTIVATED? 



I must say that the Supreme Growl was very beneficial to the Children's Hospital fund, we raised a lot of bones thanks to many Dogs efforts, PDD David Hall for Dog Day in the park \$6,085.00, Charity Dog with \$665.03 and Jr Vice and Lucky Dog Auction of \$4,548.00 can I get a big WOOD WOOF for their hard work. The Supreme Growl also benefited the Kennel to the tune of \$20,330.51 bones. The Lucky Dog worked hard for the kennel, Lucky Dog and his assistants contributed \$12,843.00 to that \$20K. 
